Position Summary

This position is a critical role as one of the first points of interaction that people have when they come into our building especially on weekdays. Beyond performing janitorial duties for the buildings and related areas, our hosts carry a welcoming demeanor that makes people feel welcome and safe in a clean and intentional environment. They provide exceptional customer service indiscriminately to people of various backgrounds. They will need to possess knowledge of our proper cleaning and safety techniques and procedures. Their mandate is to ensure that all who walk through our Community Center experience a friendly, welcoming experience.

Work Hours: Minimum 10 hours or 2 shifts. Maximum 28 hours per week.

Hours Spread: Typically 08:30am-09:00pm (Sun-Sat) window depending on rentals and facility activities. Days and times will rotate under the direction of the facilities lead.

Job Responsibilities including but not limited to:

Janitorial Responsibilities

- Vacuuming, sweeping, and mopping of flooring.
- Clean and sanitize bathrooms.
- Clean sinks, countertops, microwaves, and refrigerators in break rooms.
- Restock supplies in bathrooms, break rooms and common areas.
- Empty all trash cans and replace liners, clean receptacles as necessary.

- Cleaning window sills and windows.
- Maintain janitor closets in a clean, organized and safe manner.
- Maintain janitorial equipment in a clean, safe and operable condition.
- Proper labeling, dilution and use of all cleaning products.
- Wearing proper Personal Protective Equipment when needed.

Host Responsibilities

- Providing visible positive presence in the community center during business and non-business hours and on weekends.
- Facility Attendants will provide the very first impression to our guests.
- Commitment to the mission of 2|42 by growing in how to help people take next steps with God. They will need familiarity in various ministry teams, small group networks, and Sunday morning programming.
- Attendants should be able to confidently give a tour of the building to individuals and families and help them connect with weekend ministry programs.
- Setup/Teardown for events and some weekend activities.
- Prepare/greet and assist guest during rental events and walk in activities
- Provide a safe environment by regularly inspecting all areas of the community center.
- Act as a Point of Contact for information on 2|42 Church and the Missional Businesses.
- Open and Close the building through procedures (doors, closing, alarm, etc.)

General Responsibilities

- Any other duties as assigned

- Ability to climb and work off a 6 ft or shorter step ladder.
- Must exhibit the ability to communicate with the staff and co-workers in an appropriate and ethical manner.
- Willingness to work extra hours when necessary.

Physical Demands
